From the beginning, this Mission trip to help the impoverished people of Haiti was plagued with setbacks and unforeseen stumbling blocks. For a time, it was looking as though our adventure might end up being a great mis-adventure as the Devil seemed to be working just as hard as were.

Thankfully, through the collective prayer of Believers and a determined will, our prayers were answered and with the help of the Lord we were able to become "more than conquerors."

Open-Air Crusade

Our exclusive **Open-Air Crusade** allowed us to Minister to literally hundreds of people each night through prayer, the reading of Scripture and the laying of hands on those people in need seeking to hear the Word of God.

And just to spite the Devil, on the very first night in one miraculous moment, Demons were cast out from one young lady who had been suffering from their presence within her. Additionally, nearly one hundred people converted to Christianity during our Crusade there.



Baptism

During our trip in August, 20 adults were baptized and 16 children were presented to the Lord.



Door to Door Evangelism

In addition to the thousands of Haitians able to hear the Gospel every night through our Crusade, nearly 700 more were able to hear it one-on-one in the comfort of their homes. Praise be to God as we were Knockin' and Rockin', going door to door to spread the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ! Our efforts were rewarded as more than 100 people accepted Jesus in the privacy of their own homes.

In another snub to Satan, 15 people who had previously run away from the Lord returned to the fold. Hallelujah!

In all, some 238 people came to the Lord! All Glory to God Almighty!



Education:

If ever there was truth in a statement, then this statement applies to the Angel's Heartbeat's Drive for Supplies program!

"One Man's Junk is Another Man's Treasure."

The Drive for Supplies project serves many functions. In addition to obtaining school supplies, this is a great opportunity to promote community action. Individual families and businesses can also participate by donating their usable supplies while student volunteers who sort the materials earn student **service-learning hours**.

Each summer, Angel's Heartbeat collects and distributes new and reusable supplies to students in need. Students, teachers, and staff from Montgomery County, Maryland, donate used but reusable school supplies at the end of the school year when they clean out their lockers, book bags, and desks. The program not only benefits children in need but works to protect the environment by repurposing useable items that otherwise end up in landfills.

Realizing education is paramount to a better future, Angel's Heartbeat offers financial aid to some students to help to continue or finish their education. All thanks to the benevolence of generous donors who blessed these students through the miracle of giving.

The Stories of Need are Painful and Endless but

Through a local pastor we agreed to pay for the schooling of a young girl from a family of nine. She had never been in a school and appeared to be between the ages of 12 to 14 years of age. She came to our mobile clinic not knowing her age, the year she was born or anything relating to her birth. In fact, she had never even had a birth certificate! She was given to a member of a local church as a servant girl. Our local pastor is now looking into how soon we can get her into school.



Medical Missions

Angel's Heartbeat provides pharmaceuticals that we hand-carry in suitcases to regions in need that often have no other means of healthcare within reach. Medication that we carry varies from antibiotics, blood pressure medication, vitamins, anti-diabetics, pain relievers, antifungals and others.

Approximately 364 people received medical treatment during our trip in August. We also provided spiritual healing with prayers at the prayer-stop for their immediate needs.



Mass Weddings

Also on our trip we conducted a morning service where 32 couples got married, including one Dominican couple.

Some of us visited the poorest parts of Anse-a-Pitre along with the local pastor and former Mayor. Sadly, it was not a pretty picture. Very discreetly, I told the pastor we would help put wooden doors and windows on some of their construction projects they had already started but lacked the funds to finish.

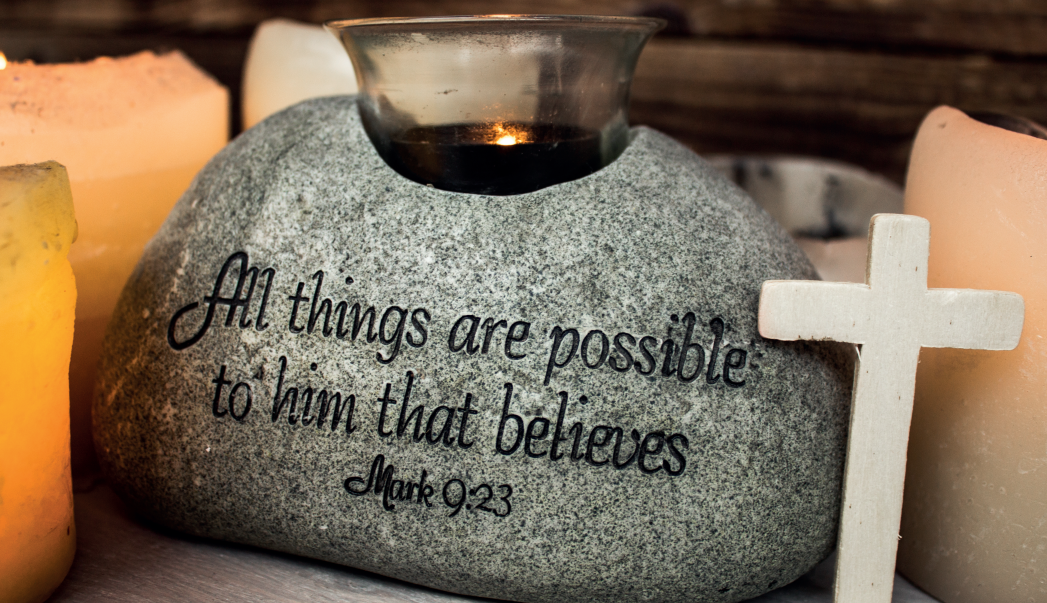
In the end, it was a great mission trip! As you can see, much has been done to benefit and improve the lives of the good people in Anse-a-Pitre, Haiti.
